WRITING 14 Characteristics of ratings → WB 22/3-4

When you rate a film (or book), think about these points:

- 1. Structure your rating in categories. A rating doesn't need to be a complete review. You may
- concentrate on what is most important to you, e.g. the acting | the plot | the special effects. 2. You don't need to write a summary of the film's plot; usually there's one on the rating website
- already. Concentrate on your opinion. 3. Explain what you like or don't like, but always be fair. It isn't necessary to make rude comments.
- 4. Words and phrases from other people's ratings can be very useful to help you to express your ideas. Examples from Ex. 13: breathtaking visuals; well-written dialogue.
- Use the simple present to describe action and scenes (When the story begins ...; The main character never knows ... etc.).
